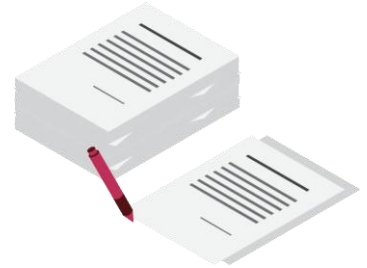


CANADA - PERU FREE TRADE AGREEMENT (FTA)

The Canada - Peru Free Trade Agreement (FTA) has boosted the competitiveness of Peruvian exports.

SIGNED	In Lima, on May 29 th , 2008
IN FORCE	Since August 1 st , 2009
ESTABLISH	100% of the negotiated items can enter Canada duty free.



Through this agreement, the countries undertake bilateral commitments in three areas:

1 TRADE

- Elimination of rates on goods.
- Promotion of multilateral investment flows.
- Expansion of the reach of each country's companies involved in key markets.

2 ENVIRONMENT

- Pursue high levels of environmental protection.
- Strengthen domestic environmental laws.

3 LABOR COOPERATION

- Respect and reinforcement of standards such as: elimination of child and forced labor, freedom of association and the right to exercise collective bargaining.
