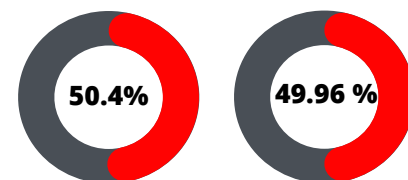

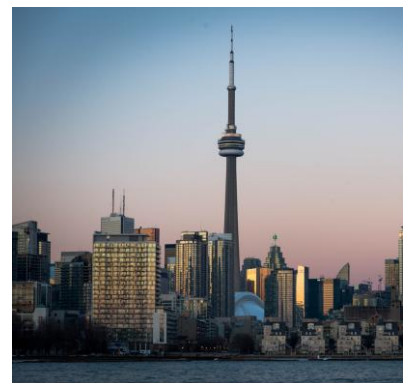


Canadian Flag
